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## **Czech Fair Play Club National Report for 2018**

The work ČKFP is focused on:

- education towards honest and fair-play behaviour
- awards for deeds, attitudes, promotion of fair play ideas
- media coverage of exemplary attitudes of awarded personalities
- international activities

### **Education**

The cooperation with AŠSK (Association of School Sports Clubs) has been in existence since 2007.

We are now included in all competitions which are organized by this association. In the calendar year of 2018, we have taken part in several national finals (RF): -Report about fair play behavior at schools (January - Plzeň)

Within the Czech Olympic Committee (ČOV) projects, we have cooperated with all parts of the ČOV, especially with the Czech Club of Olympic Participants, with the Woman Commission and with the Czech Olympic Academy (report for coaches at The UK University-Faculty of Sport and Physical Education).

In the Sazka Olympic Multiple Events (SOV), we also cooperated on the creation of the SOV Charter, which puts great emphasis on the fundamental fair play principles, both for pupils and teachers. The importance of fair play education is emphasized also in the pupil's record book for the SOV participants. We have also created methodologic materials for teachers, which helps them teach children how to act in an honest way.

In September, we started a fourth year of the project with The Czech Ice-Hockey Association (ČSLH): *"Hraj fair-cena Oldřicha Machače"* 

It is focused on the behaviour of players and coaches in youth categories. The second part of the project of cooperation ČKFP and ČSLH has already run also for the 2017/2018 season. It has monitored the situation in the top league of U16, U18 and junior club.

## <u>Awards</u>

There were 39 nominations and 29 awards.

Two Main Award for Lifelong Attitude:

*Karel Brückner* – successful football coach, example behavior on stadium, too. *Jiří Medonos* – successful tennis player, successful coach, too

Main Award for act:

*Michal Bubílek*– mountain bike (he helped to her competitor during race). 24 more sportsmen were awarded by diplomas and honour letters. Two special awards were handed on.

## Media Coverage

Cooperation with the media is a necessary part of promotion of our work. Czech TV made a recording of our FP Awarding every year, which was repeatedly broadcast on  $\check{CT}$  Sport TV channel. The TV weekly *Olympijský magazín* also presented our activities.

Fair play topics are also regularly presented in cooperation with the press department via media partners of ČOV and social networks.
