Czech Fair Play Club National Report for 2019

The work ČKFP is focused on:

- education towards honest and fair-play behaviour
- awards for deeds, attitudes, promotion of fair play ideas
- media coverage of exemplary attitudes of awarded personalities
- international activities

Education

The cooperation with AŠSK (Association of School Sports Clubs) has been in existence since 2007.

We are now included in all competitions which are organized by this association.

In the calendar year of 2019, we have taken part in several national finals (RF):

- RF volleyball – 13-14 years (March – Liberec)
- RF handball – 13-14 years (April – Velká Bystřice)
- RF floorball – 13-14 years (May – Plzeň)

- RF dodgeball– 10- 11years (June -Pecka)
- RF athletic- 13-14 years (June - Turnov)
- RF cross-country run (October - Hradec Králové)

Traditional patronages of ČKFP:

- ODM (Children Games) in Liberec region (June)
- 61st Přelouč -international football tournament for juniors (June)
- International fair play football tournament U10 -11years (December - Praha)

New patronages of ČKFP:

- 3rd Memorial of football league in Terezín, U 13 years (September)

Within the Czech Olympic Committee (ČOV) projects, we have cooperated with all parts of the ČOV, especially with the Czech Club of Olympic Participants, with the Woman Commission and with the Czech Olympic Academy (report for coaches at The UK University-Faculty of Sport and Physical Education).

In the Sazka Olympic Multiple Events (SOV), we also cooperated on the creation of the SOV Charter, which puts great emphasis on the fundamental fair play principles, both for pupils and teachers. The importance of fair play education is emphasized also in the pupil's record book for the SOV participants. We have also created methodologic materials for teachers, which helps them teach children how to act in an honest way.

In September, we started a fifth year of the project with The Czech Ice-Hockey Association (ČSLH): "**Hraj fair-cena Oldřicha Machače**"

It is focused on the behaviour of players and coaches in youth categories.

The second part of the project of cooperation ČKFP and ČSLH has already run also for the 2019/2020 season. It has monitored the situation in the top league of U16, U18 and junior club.

Awards

There were 28 nominations and 23 awards.

Main Award for Lifelong Attitude:

Antonín Panenka – successful football player, example behavior on stadium, too.

Main Awards for act:

Martina Kochánková a Radim Vrba – mountain bike (they helped to collapsed competitor during race)

Mirka Franková a Anna Stodolová – during football match came storm, they helped a boy, who was injured by lightning (thunderbolt)

Martina Součková – former rower, rescued two persons from the troubled river
19 more sportsmen were awarded by diplomas and honour letters.
