EFPM Cooperation

The ICSSPE patronage to the European Fair Play Congresses and the bilateral support means a clear evidence of the open and fruitful cooperation between both organizations and guarantee successful development for the future.

Concerning the collaboration with the European Olympic Committee EFPM will explore all possible and helpful ways to establish the next concrete steps for future cooperation.

The relationship with our long term partners like ENGSO, and CIFP, but also with CSIT, ISCA, UEPS and AIPS are more or less continuously developing and strengthened.

EFPM development towards European Sports Federations like UEFA, EHF, ETTU and others have been consolidated.

EFPM Affiliation

The Danish Football Federation, representing Denmark within EFPM for many years, cancelled their membership of reasons of internal, reorganizational and structural measures.

In the meantime the Danish Badminton Federation has shown interest and made a request of the correct procedure of affiliation.

The signature of the “Memorandum of Understanding” with the European Fencing Confederation symbolizes the first step of enlargement of EFPM affiliation and the development of cooperation with much more of the respective European Sports Federations.

EFPM Statutes

A working group composed by some EC members - Biserka Vrbek, Miroslav Cerar and GS Ioannis Psilopoulos - is in charge to elaborate a set of proposals for a further revision of the present statutes.

EFPM/EFPM Awards

The number of applications for the European Fair Play Awards is more or less the same in the last years. The active involvement and a more dynamic role of a larger number of EFPM members are key-factors to the visible success of this initiative.

The decision of the Awarding Committee for the EFP Awards 2013 will be announced at the 19th EFPM General Assembly.

Besides, a number of EFPM Awards have regularly been granted during the different European Youth Championships.

EFPM Public Performance

Play Fair Magazine as our well known communication tool contains several information about Fair Play initiatives of our members but also about established collaboration with international/European sports, cultural and educational organizations.

The respective Academic Supplement means an important added value to the magazine.

Our webpage registers a large number of visitors all over the world, especially students of universities.

Thanks a lot to Vicepresident Erdogan Aripinar for his commitment and enthusiasm for the edition of Play Fair Magazine and the Update of EFPM webpage.

EFPM flash News, under the responsibility of Treasurer Katarina Raczova, aims to inform about the “current life”, the last news of the EFPM community.

To Katarina goes our gratitude for her engaged work not only in this matter.

European Fair Play Congresses

The 18th European Fair Play Congress held in Verona, October 2012, dealt with the topic “Professional Sports and Fair Play”. The high level presentations of the invited keynote speakers meant a relevant contribution to the discussion and promotion of Fair Play principles in this specific field of sports.

The full support of the NOC of Italy and the Municipality of the City of Verona combined with the engaged work of the Italian Fair Play Committee and the local organizers, conducted by Ruggero Alcanterini, lead to a successful conclusion of this annual EFPM highlight.

We are convinced that the 19th EFP Congress 2013 in Istanbul “The Olympic and Paralympic Movement - An Alliance for Fair Play” will continuously add another outstanding event to the EFPM development.

Two of the biggest sports movements are at the first time on the scope of the congress topic and we are expecting some exciting presentations of the keynote speakers coming from all over Europe.
