2018 ANNUAL GATHERING

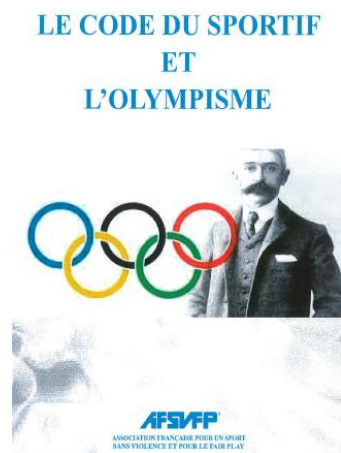

ACTIVITIES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND COMMISSIONS.

The Board of Directors met four times in March, June, September and December.

An individual member, Mr. Philippe DALLONGEVILLE was co-opted at the meeting of the Board of Directors of September 13, 2018 to replace Mr. Jacques TROUVE who wished to withdraw. Mr. Philippe DALLONGEVILLE was nominated as new General Secretary

Everyone will have had the opportunity to discover the publication entitled "The Code of Sport and Olympism" which contains the summary of the work of the gathering in Clermont-Ferrand.

The communication commission has taken new initiatives to provide us with modern means.



A letter was sent to the regional and departmental bodies to obtain the designation of the referents. The members of the board of directors will also intervene according to their implantation on the territory so that we can actually create an effective network.

The commission will set up a special fair play prize project in addition to the traditional podium at competitions, in order to reward values such as loyalty, fairness, respect and camaraderie.

A journalists' club has been set up to promote the AFSVFP, its values and actions, to be reactive on certain events and also to write feature articles.

The website is being improved. The A.F.S.V.F.P. opened up to social networks.

The commission is also working on relaunching the media we need, badges (pin's) and the "double decimeter" for schoolchildren, in order to promote the 7 principle of "Code du Sport".

In terms of international relations, the AFSVFP participated in the 24th congress of the EFPM on November 22 in Brussels, represented by M. Jean-Pierre MOUGIN, AFSVFP President and Mrs. Marie José LALLART.

M. Jean-Pierre MOUGIN receive at this occasion, the highest award, the European Fair Play Plaque of Merit and Diploma under the auspices of the European Olympic Committees, on behalf of Talalelei GRAY(Australia - Rugby, Toulouse) for outstanding sporting behavior facing a wounded opponent.

By pursuing actions to position the humanist values of the SPORTS SPIRIT and the ethical rules of the SPORTS CODE, A.F.S.V.F.P. leads a major public interest action to preserve the values of freedom, equality, fraternity and secularism.
