Nevertheless, the permanent consultations with the Austrian Government, the Ministry of Sports, the Municipality of Vienna about financial support to the establishment of the EFPM office and staff have not lead to any success up to now.

We will continue the consultation and discussion with the relevant partners.

EFPM Cooperation

The relationship with our long term partners like EOC, ICSSPE, ENGSO, EPAS, ISCA is continuously strengthened.

The cooperation with our partners based on a “Memorandum of Understanding”, like EFC, EHF, ETU, EPC, EUSA, CSIT, is developing steadily and sometimes leads to EFPM involvement in the Fair Play initiatives of the respective partners, i.e. Fair Play Awarding at Youth Championships.

EFPM Affiliation

EFPM has elaborated and signed a “Memorandum of Understanding” with the EPC, EUSA, EHF and ETU and step by step the establishment of a Fair Play Network in Europe will be realized.

The “Memorandum of Understanding” with the International Sport Press Association – AIPS Europe - is now ready for signature at our General Assembly in Riga.

The specific role of the media in the world of sports and the agreement of cooperation opens the scope for promoting and reimplementing the Olympic values and the fair play principles in all fields of sports, on the pitch, within the sports organizations, in the structure, the rules and regulations, in the media, spectators etc.
