Public Performance

In combination with the Academic Supplement, the EFPM Flash News (edited by Katarina Razcova) and our webpage it gives a relevant overview of the EFPM development, several Fair Play activities in Europe and different initiatives of the EFPM members.

ASKÖ is continuously supporting the EFPM, the obligations and activities of the President, especially in covering the costs for the relevant fulfillment of the position.

Nevertheless, for a more powerful and active role within the European Sports Community the EFPM needs to establish its own office.

This means to raise money, subsidy and financial support. Therefore we must continue the consultation and discussion with relevant, governmental and nongovernmental, partners.

EFPM Cooperation

The relationship with long term international/European organisations have been intensified with common fair play activities set up within championships and consultations with relevant representatives.

The EFPM has attended several events represented by its respective members, for example:

Prof. Carlos Goncalves, honorary member, represented the EFPM at the ENGSO General Assembly, where Carlos Cardoso (POR) was elected new President. The intent of a joint venture, signing a MoU, is an option for the next meeting.

The cooperation with the EUSA was highlighted by presence of the EFPM at their Convention, Workshops and Championships by Vicepresident Miroslav Cerar and Biserka Vrbek, EC-member.

The CSIT World Sports Games, a set of competitions with about 5000 athletes, for the first time announced Fair Play Awards and followed the proposed procedure (Green Card) of EFPM with big success (17 applications).

The EFPM Awarding at the Junior and Cadet Championships of the EFC during the last years has become a regular and established one, thanks to the work of Katarina Raczova.

For the first time EFPM has been involved in the Awarding at the Junior Championships of the ETTU and it seems to be the inauguration of steps for cooperation (MoU) in the future.

EFPM Affiliation

The EFPM has worked very hard to reactivate the relationship with Belgian Sports:

The Panathlon Wallonie Organisation submitted an application for affiliation, authorized by the respective NOC, fully supported by the EFPM EC.

Since the very beginning the EFPM tried again and again to convince the British Olympic family to become an EFPM member.

Now, what a big success, the BOA has submitted an application for affiliation to the GA.

Both affiliations are proposals on the Agenda of GA and supported by the EC members.

Besides, EFPM awards have been granted at some European Youth Championships.

At least the EC discussed the Awards regulations and prepared a proposal for a little change to the GA.

EFP Congresses

The 20th EFP Congress in Riga, Capitol of Culture of Europe 2014, discussing the topic “The Fair Play Values – bridge between sports and culture for Europe without discrimination” was a big success for the scientific part and also honored by the attendance of the President of the Republic of Latvia, Andris Berzins, by the IPC-President, Sir Philip Craven, and last but not least by the UN Adviser for Sports for Development and Peace, Wilfried Lemke.

The Latvian Olympic Committee and the Latvian Olympians Club, especially Raimonds Bergmanis and Baiba Veisa, led the congress and the 20th Anniversary to a big victory for Fair Play.

The Book of Proceedings will show this in an impressive way including all the presentations and some photos as a reminder of the Riga days.

There are no applications for organizing the 22nd and 23rd Congress and GA up to now.

Brighton Declaration on Women and Sports

At our last General Assembly in Riga, October 2014, the “Brighton Declaration on Women and Sports” has been signed and afterwards submitted to the EWS.

EFPM takes this obligation very serious and invites all members to inaugurate the signature of this very important content within the respective organisations.
